This Association consists of more than 600 life members and 400 associate members. Every year AET conducts its annual conference in various colleges in Tamil Nadu. This year Kandaswami Kandar's College had the opportunity to host the conference. A prestigious moment in the history of Kandaswami Kandar's College.

The Inaugural Function began at 9.30am on 28th Nov 2015. **Dr P Loganathan** HOD of Economics welcomed the gathering. The Organizing Secretary of the Conference **Dr A Shanmugasundaram** Associate Professor of Economics presented the themes of the Conference succinctly. The Kandaswami Kandar's educational Trusts President and Secretary **Dr. R. Somasundaram, Dr. K. Nedunchezhian**, Vice-President and **Dr. Major R. Aurul**, Principal of the college graced the occasion.

The Presidential Address was delivered by **Dr R Balasubaramaniam**, D.G Vaishnava College, Chennai. The Inaugural Address was delivered by **Dr C Thangamuthu**, Former Vice – Chancellor of Bharathidasan University, Trichy. He gave an excellent account on the importance of Information in the **'Knowledge Economy'**. India, to be competitive and to achieve a higher rate of economic growth, has to invest heavily on the promotion of technology and has to create intellectual capital. The Information Technology (IT) sector has been growing at a faster rate and this is going to revolutionize the economic transformation of Indian economy, he observed. A Special Address was delivered by **Dr M Manivannan**, Registrar, Periyar University, Salem. In his speech he dwelt upon the importance of educational institutions like Kandaswami Kandar's Trust which provides primary, secondary and higher education, especially in the rural areas. These institutions there by elevate the status of individuals as well as the region.

On this occasion awards were given away by the AET. The Senior Economist Award – 2015 was given to **Dr V Mohanasundaram**, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Economics, PSG College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore and the Junior Economist Award to **R Mariappan**.

Four Technical Sessions were conducted in the Conference on the themes

A critical evaluation of economic reforms helped to understand the growth and progress of Indian economy and to underline the importance of reduction of poverty and inequality in the country. As a subject "Information Economics" has grown in a big way and nearly 11 Economists got **Nobel Prize** in the field of

Game Theory. The AET called for empirical works on the application of game theory. An analysis of different dimensions of Tamil Nadu was undertaken by many authors and they presented their findings in the Conference. After quoting a few significant improvements in the State in the fields of health, infrastructure and industrialization, the authors called for an efficient allocation and proper utilization of financial and physical resources so as to cover the short – fall. The agricultural and industrial activities in Karur and Namakkal Districts, their growth and the challenges they are facing were discussed.

Dr. A. Shanmugasundaram of Kandaswami Kandar's College has been elected as the new AET President for the year 2015-16 in the AET executive and General Body Meeting.

The Valedictory Address was delivered by the "Son of the Soil" and proud alumnus of KKC school **Dr S Neelakandan**, Former Director, Madras Institute of Development Studies (MIDS). As a voracious reader, prolific writer and a great teacher, he gave a resounding lecture. He called Teaching as a "Meta Trade" and as a "Positive – Sum – Game". 


