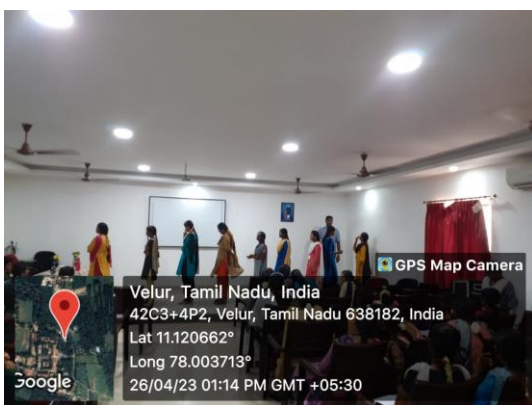
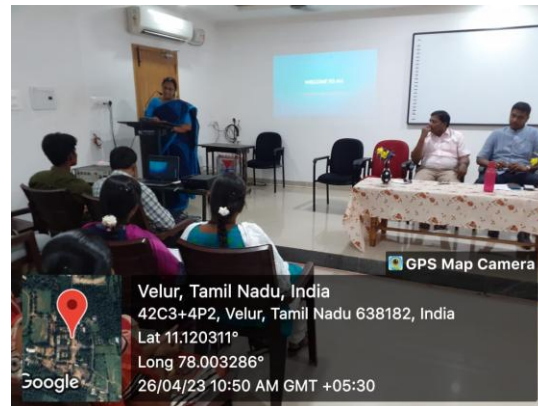
Soft skill development cell conducted a workshop on 26th April for all final year students.
